STATEMENT OF SENATOR GREGORIO B. HONASAN II

Honored guests, industry leaders, fellow public servants, friends, ladies and gentlemen, a pleasant day to everyone.

I laud the Japanese People and the Japanese Government, especially His Excellency Prime Minister Shinzo Abe for

providing continued assistance, more investments in human capital and more trade and employment opportunities to the Philippines.
